### SEASONAL FLU VACCINE

Clinics to administer seasonal flu vaccine are scheduled for the following dates and locations:

**Chautauqua County Health Department, 319 Central Ave, Dunkirk, NY**  
Wednesday, December 16, 2009 from 1 – 6 pm

**Chautauqua County Health Department, 110 E 110 E. Fourth St, Jamestown, NY**  
Thursday, December 17, 2009 from 1-4 pm

**Chautauqua County Health Department, 7 N. Erie St, Mayville, NY**  
Thursday, December 17, 2009 from 1 – 6 pm

*NOTE: Your own doctor may be your best option for getting seasonal flu vaccine. Many health care providers have received supplies of seasonal flu vaccine, while other providers are still waiting to receive their vaccines. Providers will continue to receive vaccines in the coming weeks, and vaccination for seasonal flu will continue through December, in time to provide protection against the seasonal flu.*

### H1N1 FLU VACCINE

New York State Governor Patterson has announced that H1N1 flu vaccine should be made available to all individuals who want it, including those who are not in the priority groups.

Clinics to administer H1N1 flu vaccine are scheduled for the following dates and locations:

**Tuesday December 29, 2009 9am to 6pm**
- **Joint Neighborhood Project; 535 East Second St. Jamestown, NY**  
**Wednesday December 30, 2009 10am to 2pm**

**The following school-located clinics will be open to only school students and staff during the morning and then school district residents from 12pm – 3pm:**

- **Fredonia High School - Wednesday, December 16 - 12pm – 3pm**
- **Westfield Central School - Friday, December 18 - 12pm – 3pm**

The Chautauqua County Health Department will be offering seasonal and H1N1 influenza vaccinations at the following vaccination clinics ***The Health Department clinics will be billing insurance or collecting \$5.00 for those that are uninsured.***
