

Senior Restaurant Dining Out Program Ticket Order

Tickets for the Restaurant Dining Out Program that can be used at participating restaurants county wide are available to any county residents age 60 and over who fill out a registration form. **There is a \$3.50 suggested Donation for each ticket**, good for one complete meal per person per day. Tickets will be provided regardless of an ability to donate.

1. To use your tickets, simply dine at any participating restaurant. If you are dining in a group, please check with restaurant for reservations if needed.
2. Tell your server you are using a dining coupon prior to ordering your meal (restaurants may have limited menu options. Please check with your server.)
3. Each Coupon is good for one complete meal. (as listed on designated menus.)
4. Sign and date your ticket only when you use it.

Tickets can be used only for designated menu items- Please do not ask your server to apply them to anything else. Tip is not included in the donation.

Tickets can be ordered for the new quarter on the 15th of the preceding month. Please check your tickets upon receipt to make sure when they are active.

Tickets are not transferable, replaceable or refundable. The Office for the Aging is not responsible for tickets that are unused, lost, destroyed or stolen. Office for the Aging may limit tickets if quantity order exceeds reasonable usage.

Cash donations for tickets acquired at the office should be in the exact amount. **There is a suggested \$3.50 donation per ticket ordered.** Please make checks or money orders payable to **The Office for the Aging**. You may also use food stamps toward this donation. Please do not send cash through the mail.
